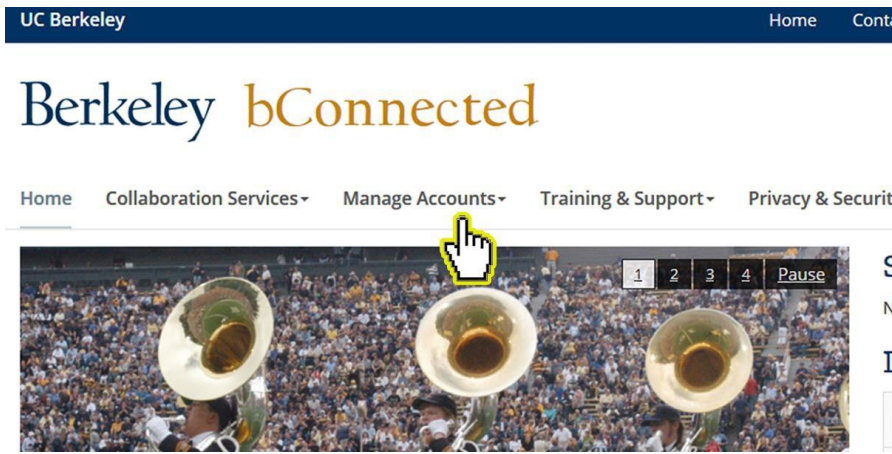


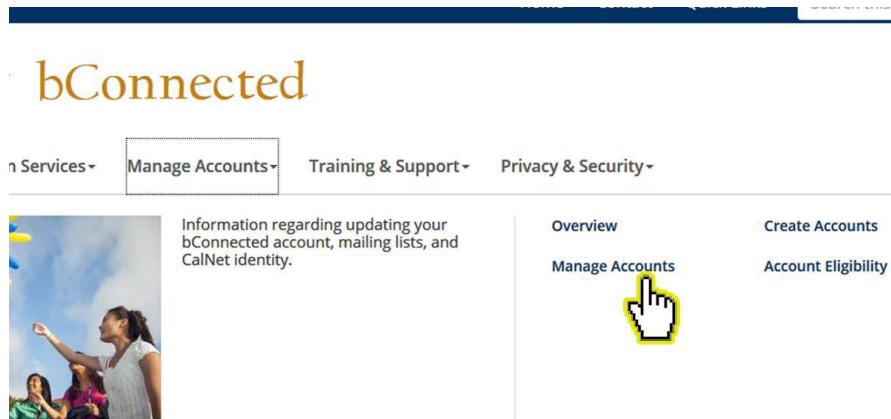


How do I create an AirBears2 Key?

Step	Procedure
1	Go to bconnected.berkeley.edu and Click the Manage Accounts tab.

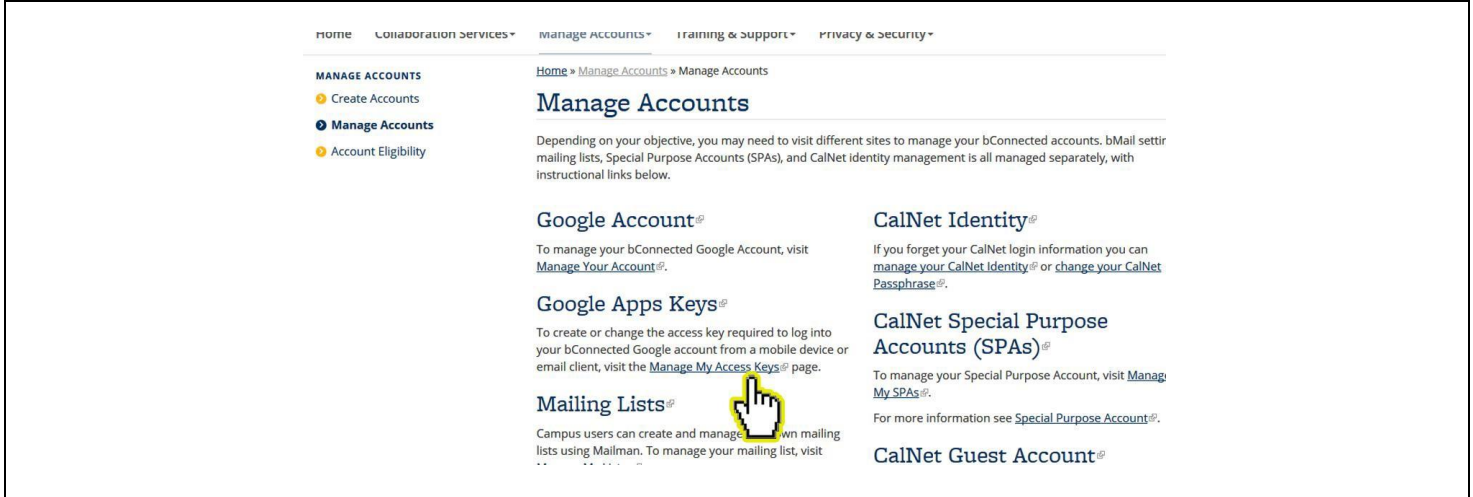


Step	Procedure
2	On the right side of the ensuing menu, click on the Manage Accounts link.



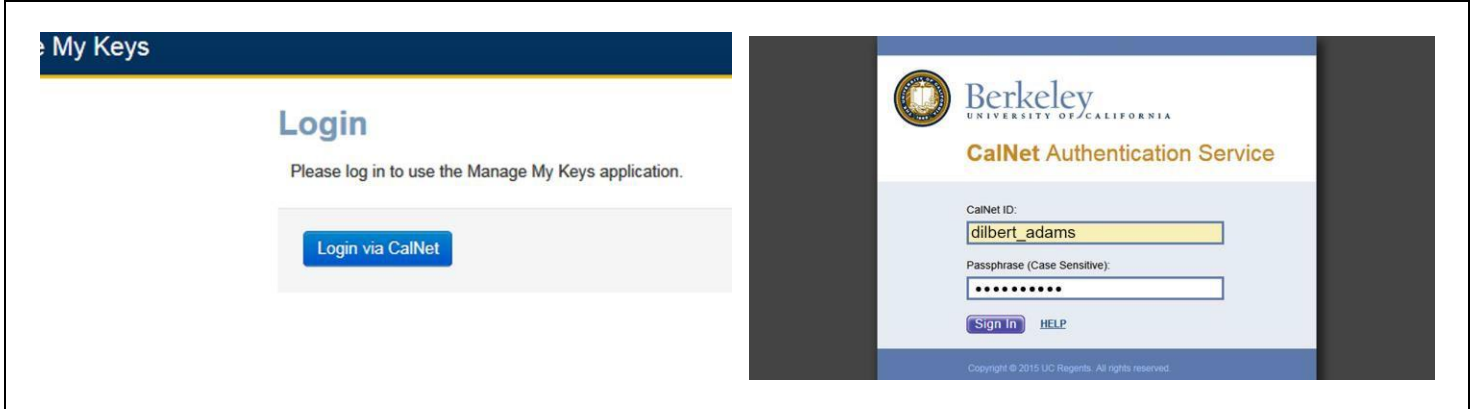

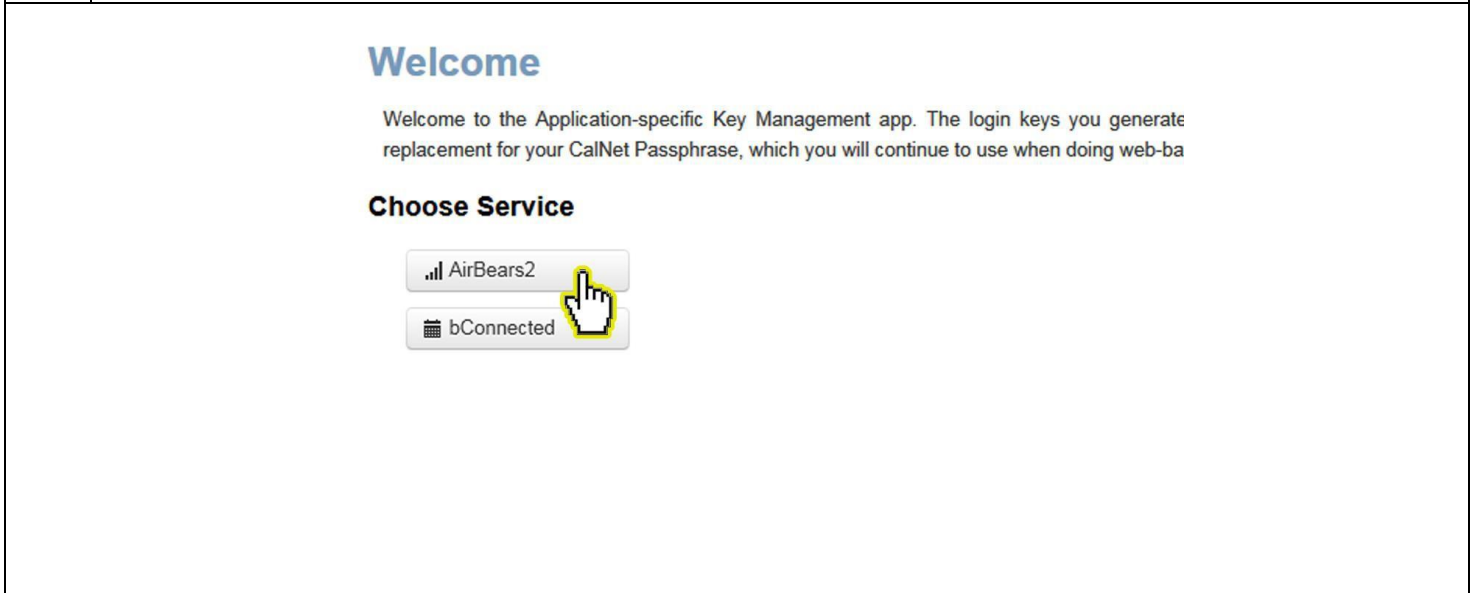
