

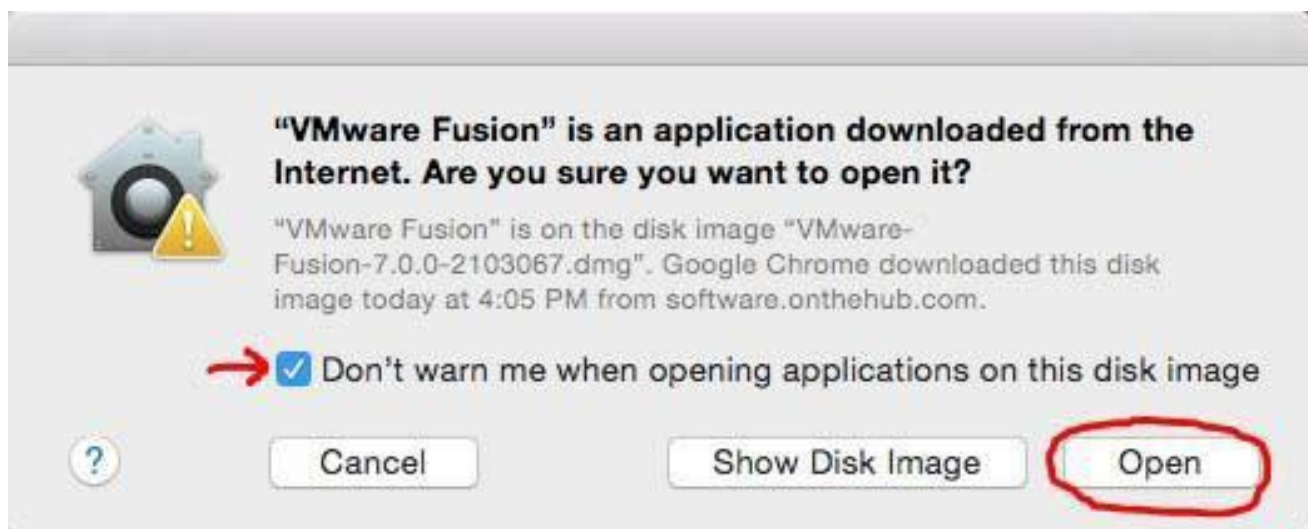


How do I Install VMware Fusion on my Mac Computer?

Step	Procedure
1	Open VMware Fusion 7 from the location where you saved it to your Mac.

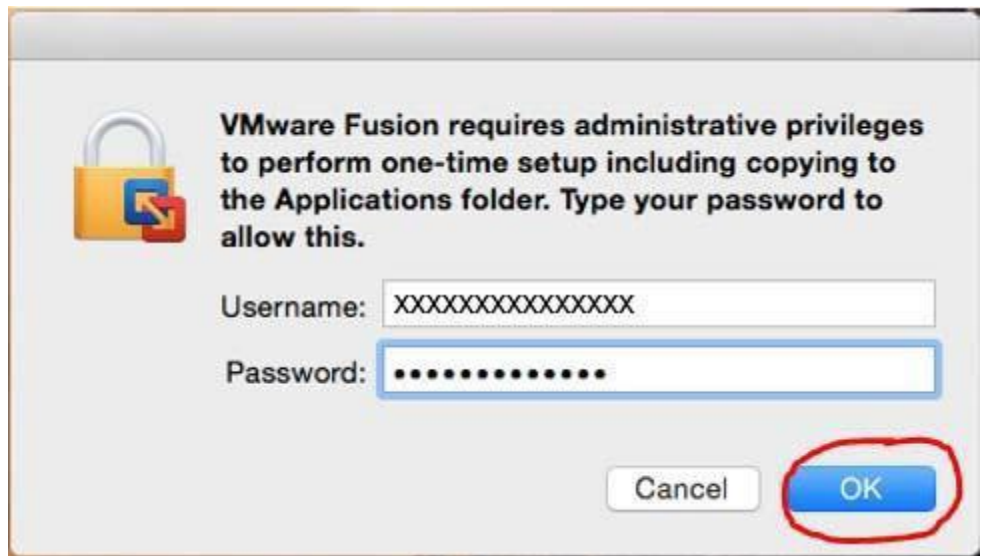

2	If you get the warning below, check the box "Don't warn me when opening applications on this disk image" and click Open .



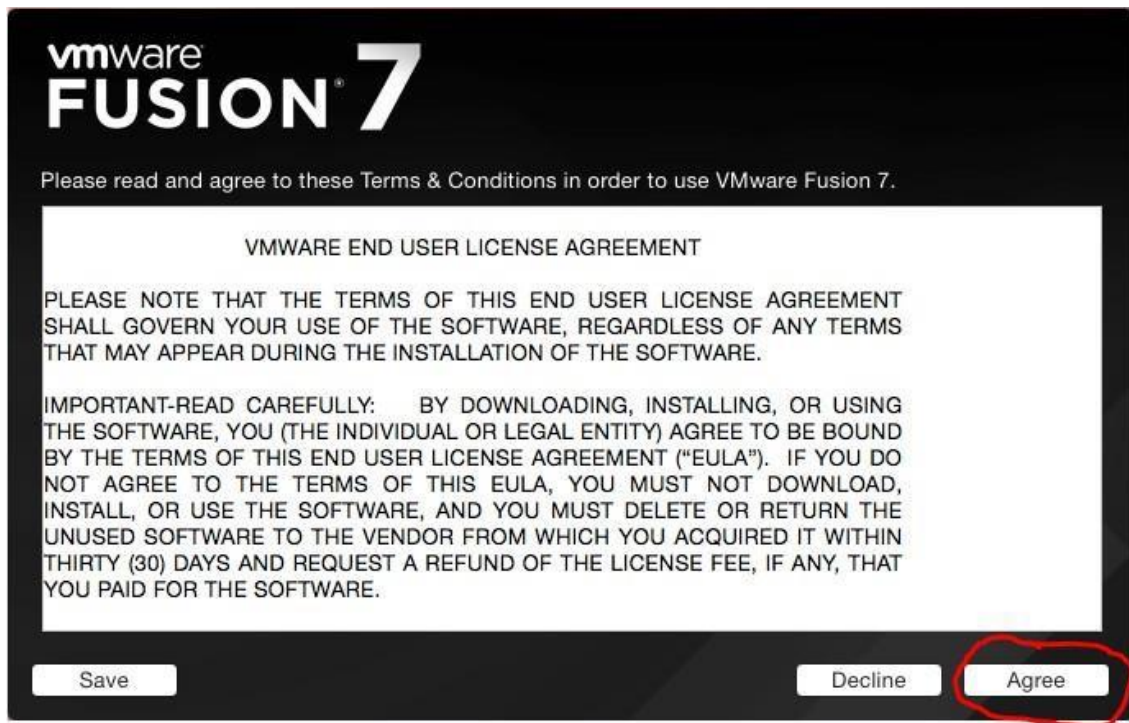
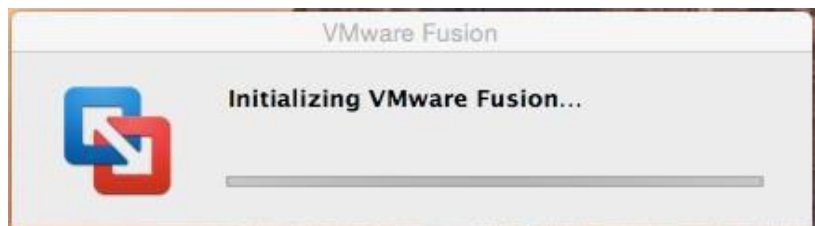

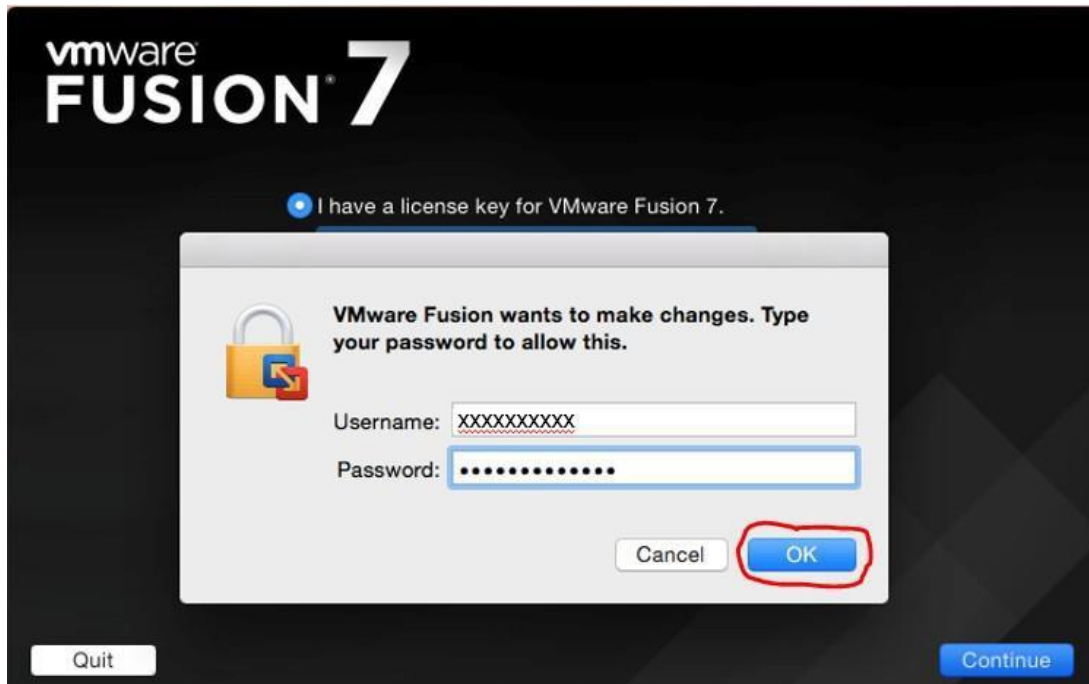
4	Your software will start to install. Click "Agree" at the "VMware end user license agreement" .

9	<p>However, if the following screen comes up informing you that there is an update for Fusion, please click the button "Download and Install" to install the latest update for the software.</p> <p>Once that is done running, you will be prompted to restart the windows virtual machine.</p> <p>Next you can make an appointment by sending a message to helpdesk@haas.berkeley.edu to have a Windows image installed on your virtual machine. The image will include Windows 7 and Office 2013.</p>
